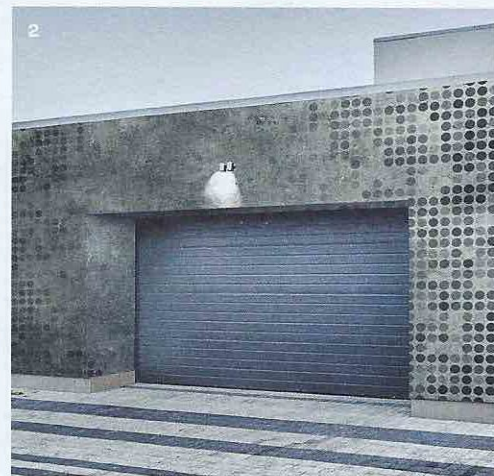
2 Indoor/Outdoor

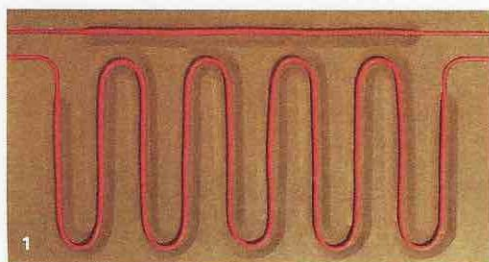
3 Wall Armour

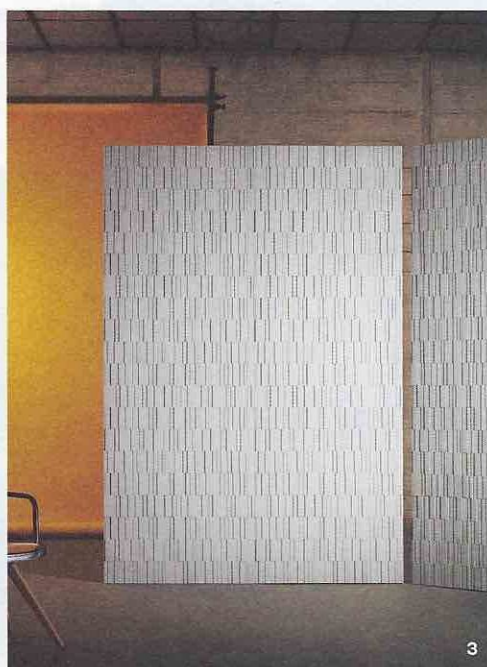

1 Warm Walls

U.K. manufacturer Clayworks has introduced a wall and ceiling system that adds gentle radiant heat to clay panels. The modules connect to a boiler tank or manifold, similarly to the way in-floor heating would, but they have the added benefit of absorbing odours and reducing allergens. clay-works.com

2 Flexible Stone

VersaLite Stone natural stone veneer panels make it easy to apply the look of slate, sandstone or quartzite to interior walls. Available with rigid, fabric or translucent backings, the panels can follow the curve of any surface and are produced in 24 different colour and texture options. versalitestone.com

3 Minimal Masonry

Concrete LCDA has expanded its Panbeton foam-backed concrete panel collection with new designs by Patrick Norguet, including the building-block-inspired Harmony (shown).
