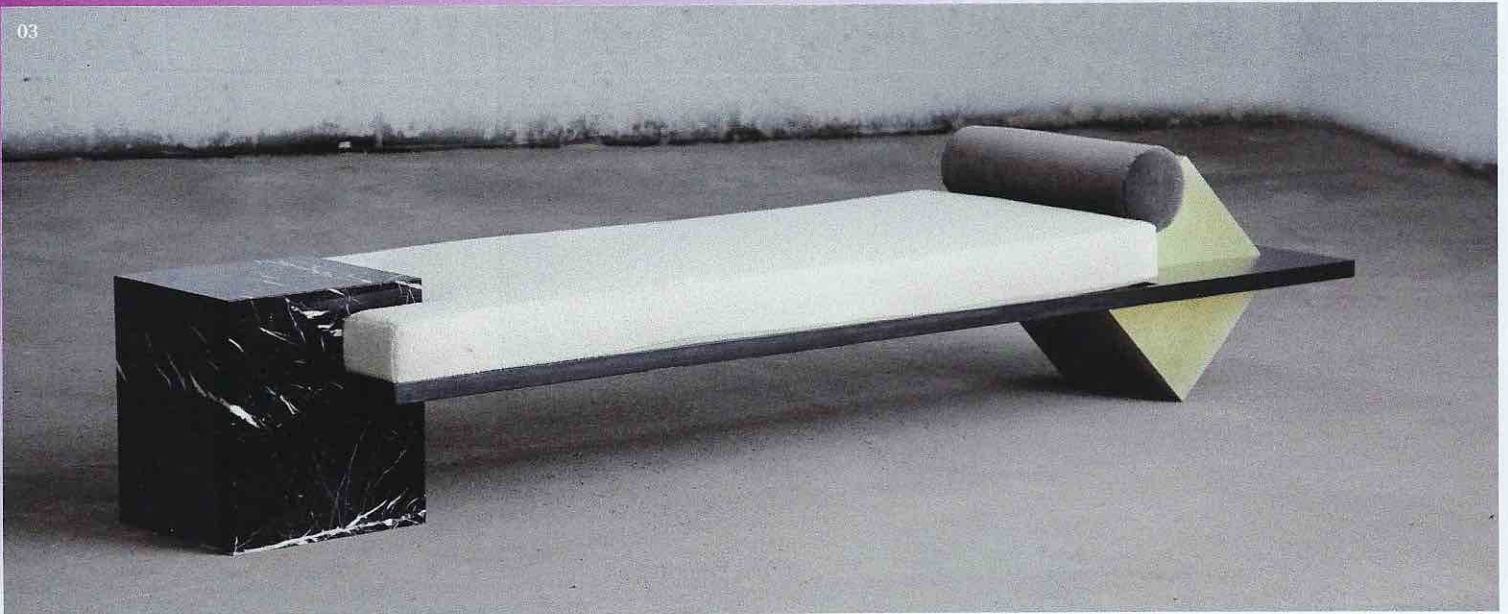

03 SLASH OBJECTS, COEXIST DAYBED
Slash Objects, founded by Arielle Assouline-Lichten and part of Slash Projects, is the 2019 American Design Honors recipient. The Greenpoint studio specializes in unconventional material combinations—think postconsumer recycled rubber with concrete, marble, and brass.

04 ZIMMERMAN WORKSHOP, OT/TRA
Ot/trá is a collection of furniture launched by Brooklyn-based architecture firm Zimmerman Workshop. Its pieces use bentwood without any reinforcement or metal structure.

05 OCRUM DESIGN, ORIZON MIRROR
Created by Sean Zhang and Luca Zeffiro, and informed by the founders' Chinese and Italian roots, Ocrum takes a hands-on approach to texture and material. A unique ripple effect and a metallic glaze on this mirror's lower half make looking into Orizon feel like gazing out to sea through a porthole.

06 ARMADA, CHAIR
From a studio in the Brooklyn Navy Yard, Armada designs and manufactures custom wooden furniture, like this chair of oxidized oak, putting a modern twist on classic designs.

07 BLACKTABLE, COLUMN TABLE
Founded in 2013 by Colombian-born architect Carlos Meza, Blacktable creates works that combine craft and traditional materials with the latest in digital manufacturing technology. The Column tables are constructed of birch plywood, bent and finished to look as though milled from a single piece of wood.
